



Archbishop Ryan High School Financial Information 2011-2012 School Year

Archbishop Ryan High School is part of the secondary school system of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. The school system determines tuition costs, and tuition payments are deposited directly into the diocesan account. Tuition primarily covers the cost of salary and benefits, utilities and some major capital improvements. Fees are deposited into the school account and are used to pay all other expenses.

The Advancement Office coordinates an extensive fundraising program that defrays costs and funds several tuition assistance programs. For the 2011-2012 school year, the amount of tuition assistance and funding for school programs from organizations and individuals was almost \$1,000,000.

The information provided in this brochure is intended to help you understand the costs associated with a Ryan education. It also includes a detailed explanation of the financial aid possibilities offered by the Archdiocesan programs, the Ryan tuition assistance program and other programs offered by individuals, foundations and other organizations.

The total cost of a Ryan education is often significantly lower than the cost of a high school education in local public and private schools and high schools throughout the United States. However, we do realize how difficult it is for many families to pay tuition and fees. Every effort is made to hold costs down as much as possible and to seek out alternative sources of funding for programs and tuition assistance.



Tuition Payment Schedules — 2011-2012 School Year

Tuition for students in the secondary schools of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia is **\$5,600.00** for the 2011-2012 fiscal year. Families with two or more students in Archdiocesan high schools pay full tuition for two students, thus when three or more students in the same family are in high school at the same time, each receives a discount. The family rate discount does not apply to students in parish schools or in private high schools.

Archdiocesan parishes also pay an assessment to help maintain the secondary schools. Parents must pay a supplemental tuition fee of **\$1,150.00** if the student is not Catholic, or if the student is a Catholic of another rite, or if the family is not registered in any parish, or if in the judgment of the pastor the family is not practicing the faith or contributing to the Church according to their means.

Financial Aid at Archbishop Ryan

Archbishop Ryan High School's tuition assistance is handled through the President's Office and the Admissions Office. This includes specific scholarship and financial aid programs such as: the Officer Danny Boyle Foundation Scholarship, the Dave Palmer Memorial Foundation Scholarship, Ryan Responds, Sponsor A Student, the Alumni Tuition Assistance Program and others. Each case is addressed individually *only after* families have applied through Archdiocesan programs described below. Applications become available at the end of January and the end of August. Parents considering enrolling their child at Ryan can schedule a meeting to discuss tuition assistance and to review the family's potential eligibility for various forms of tuition assistance.

Archbishop Ryan Academic Scholarship Test

Archbishop Ryan Academic Scholarship Test will take place on November 12. The test is for eighth grade students only. Based on the results of the scholarship test, four-year scholarships will be awarded to 50 or more eighth graders. The award amount is \$1000, \$2000 or \$3000 per year. Archdiocesan Grants

TAP AND BLOCS FORMS ARE AVAILABLE IN JANUARY IN THE PRESIDENT'S OFFICE AND FINANCE OFFICE

1. The major source of financial assistance at Archbishop Ryan is administered through the **Tuition Assistance Program (TAP)** of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. Grants are awarded based upon the need across all diocesan secondary schools. Please note:

- * Applications are available in the Finance Office and President's Office in January.
- * The filing deadline is April 15th. Early filing is recommended.
- * The application, latest copy of W-2 Form and tax forms and application fee must be forwarded directly to the Archdiocese.

2. An additional Archdiocesan tuition assistance source is the **Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC)** program, administered through **Business Leadership Organized for Catholic Schools (BLOCS)** and an independent financial analysis organization, **Private School Aid Service (PSAS)**. Please note:

- * Applications are available in the Finance Office and President's Office in the winter for the following school year.
- * Families with one dependent/child must have an income of \$60,000 or less to qualify. *(For each additional dependent/child, add \$10,000.)*
- * Financial qualification does not guarantee aid. Those families determined to be the most financially needy in the diocese (K-12) and Archbishop Ryan are awarded funds first.
