# Financial Information for 2010—2011

Archbishop Ryan High School is part of the secondary school system of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. The school system determines tuition costs, and tuition payments are deposited directly into the diocesan account. Tuition primarily covers the cost of salary and benefits, utilities and some major capital improvements. Fees are deposited into the school account and are used to pay all other expenses.

This brochure identifies and explains the various fees and when each fee is due. It is intended to serve as an aid to you in planning for school related expenses.

## **FEES—ALL STUDENTS**

**School Fee** \$590.00

The fee is paid in two parts:

Part 1—\$295.00

(Due June 15, 2010 – Non-refundable)

Part 2—\$295.00

(Due February 15, 2011 – Non-refundable)

**Fundraiser Fee** \$180.00

This fee is not optional. It is required for all students.

***Please Note:*** Our Fundraisers support our activities and sports. None of the activities and sports fees cover more than a portion of the costs. For this reason, students who do not fulfill their fundraising requirement will not be permitted to participate in the extracurricular program until the fee is paid.

## **NEW STUDENTS (Incoming Eighth Graders)**

Registration Fee \$200.00

(\$100.00 due when registering, non-refundable)

(\$100.00 balance due by March 1<sup>st</sup>, the amount refundable up to June 1 is \$100.00)

*It is important to remember.*

In order to receive a student's roster, July and August's tuition payment and the school fee must be paid.

In order to receive a report card no more than two months tuition can be past due.

In order to begin the second semester and to remain on the rolls thereafter, at least half of the annual tuition must be paid (5 months)

Each student must have a separate check to pay tuition and fees.

A service charge of \$10.00 is charged for each tuition payment not paid by month's end.

Students may not participate in school activities including Proms and Graduation until all financial responsibilities are paid-to-date or paid-in-full.

Archdiocesan policy states that students withdrawing from Archbishop Ryan High School must fulfill all financial obligations before an official transcript or records can be released to the next school

**Students with a valid Ryan Student ID card are admitted free of charge to home regular season sports events and the school shows.**

**SCHOOL FEE:** \$590.00 due in two payments of \$295.00 on June 15 and February 15.
