The goal of the **Archbishop Ryan High School Shadow Program** is to assist prospective students in making an informed decision concerning their enrollment at Archbishop Ryan. The Office of Admissions takes seriously the **Shadow Program** and therefore has put forth guidelines to insure both the **Shadow Program's** purpose and success.

1. Students currently in the **eight grade** and or **transfer students** from another high school are eligible for the program.
2. The Office of Admissions respectfully requests at least a one week notice for a shadow appointment. Every effort will be made to honor reasonable requests within the confines of the Ryan school calendar/schedule.
3. The Office of Admission will partner the guest student with a current Ryan student in the year the prospective student will enter. Requests for certain student will be considered, yet final determination rests with the Office of Admissions. Consideration will also be given to academic/extracurricular interests and or the parish / neighborhood.
4. Shadow days are arranged **Tuesday through Thursday**, beginning at 7:45 A.M and concluding at 1:45 P.M. Students will receive a roster for the day upon arrival.
5. Guest students are asked to arrive/depart from the President's Office, located on the south side of the school. (St Francis statue)
6. Guest students are expected to be in their own school uniform.
7. A lunch will be provided to all our shadow participants.
