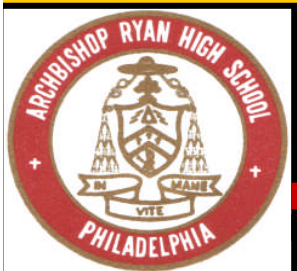

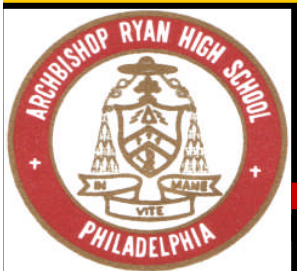

Tuition Assistance

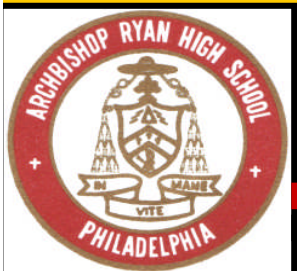
More than 25% of the student body receives some form of scholarship or tuition assistance





The Academic Scholarship Program

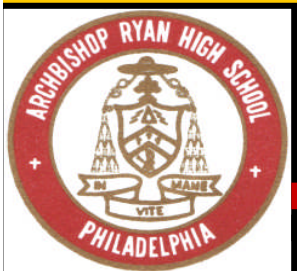
- **Academic Scholarships** are awarded based on the results of the scholarship exam administered in November
- **Eighth grade students** on the school's mailing list receive a letter inviting them to sit for the exam
- **For the Class of 2013**, 15 four year \$2000 and 35 four year \$1000 scholarships will be awarded.





Tuition Assistance

- Tuition assistance is awarded based on financial need as determined by an evaluation of a family's financial circumstance. The evaluation is conducted by the Ryan review committee or outside organizations.

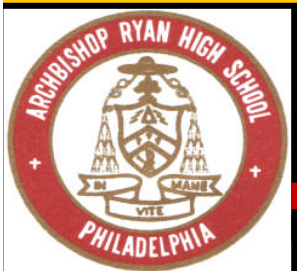

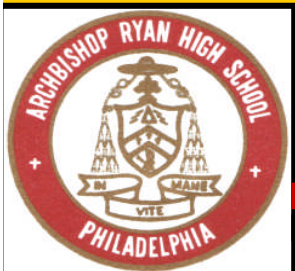

- EITC (Educational Improvement Tax Credit) awarded through foundations



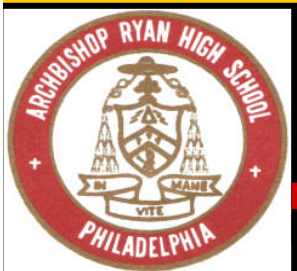


EITC

Educational Improvement Tax Credit

PA business make a donation to an approved foundation and receive a tax credit.

Schools are asked to submit applications from qualified families

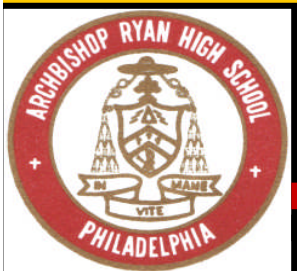




EITC

Family Qualifications

- Allowed income level- \$50,000 plus \$10,000 for each dependent child
 - \$60,000 – 1 child
 - \$70,000- 2 children
 - \$80,000 – 3 children
- Income must be documented and special circumstances cannot be considered





Application Process

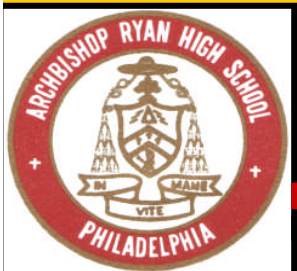
- Carefully complete
- Where allowed explain circumstances
- Must provide documentation of financial circumstances
 - Copy of most recent tax return with W2's





Ryan's Alumni Tuition Assistance Program

- Assistance awarded based on annual application
 - Half of the awarded is credited to the students account at the end of the first marking period and half at the end of the third marking period
 - Passing grades required in all subjects and conduct

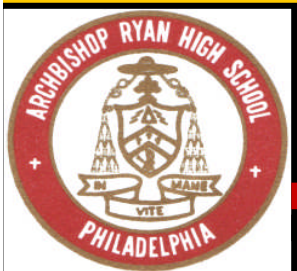

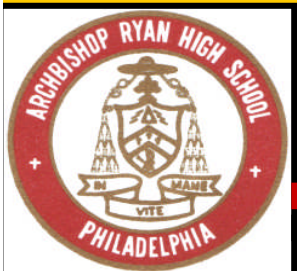

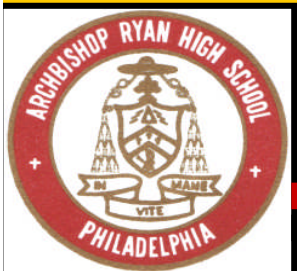
